Review of Chiropractic Spinal Manipulation on Children Under 12

The Victorian Minister for Health has asked Safer Care Victoria (SCV) to lead an independent national review of the practice of spinal manipulation on children under 12 years, and for the findings of that review to be provided to all Australian Health Ministers later this year, including any need for changes to the law.

While the review will examine all available research, it will also call for submissions from members of the public to ensure an informed decision is made about the future of chiropractic care for children under the age of 12.

As the President of the Australian Chiropractors Association (ACA), I represent more than 3,000 chiropractors in Australia. We are the peak body for the profession and strongly believe the review should not jeopardise the level of care chiropractors in Australia can offer. We firmly believe chiropractors play an important role in your family's healthcare.

The profession would greatly appreciate your support to ensure that chiropractic care is available to all Australians without unnecessary age restriction. As a parent of one of the 30,000 children that Australian chiropractors see every week, there is no better way to share how meaningful chiropractic care is, than with your personal experience.

The current review is being conducted by SCV, and as part of the review they want to hear from Australians who have received chiropractic care.
